 Write a haiku about nature underground or in unexpected places—water dripping, rats, echoes, wind in the tunnels.

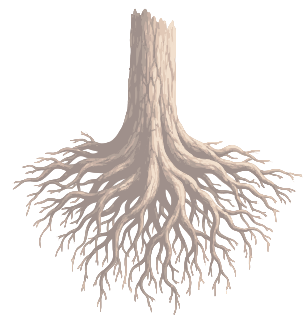
